MAHATMA IN PUNE

Acutely aware that Mahatma Gandhi was the most important leader of the Indian freedom struggle, the British were cautious with the way they dealt with him, which reflected in TOI reports on his arrests. It was not without reason that Pune's high-security Yerawada jail and the sprawling Aga Khan palace (where Kasturba Gandhi breathed her last) were hand-picked by the British to lodge Gandhi on several occasions mainly between 1924 and 1943.

TOI then routinely reported on Gandhi's health when he was fasting in captivity based on the daily medical bulletin the authorities released.

But his Poona connection wasn't limited to jail terms. In September 1924, TOI reported on Gandhi's hectic schedule of rallies and meetings, and also when there was discontent brewing in the city against him in 1934, with many questioning his stand against untouchability.

His assassination in 1948 led to riots in Pune and an imposition of curfew.

POONA, January 27.

Mr. M. K. Gandhi and Mrs. Sarojini Naidu were released at 11 p.m. from Yeravda Jail. They were taken by motor car to Chinchwad Station and there they boarded the 11-15 train for Bombay. First class carriages were reserved for them and they were accompanied by four attendants.

Mr. Gandhi's release was delayed at his own request, presumably to avoid the attentions of the crowd. The train is due in Bombay at 5.45 on Tuesday morning.

Mr. Gandhi is stated to have handed over to the Superintendent of the Jail a document the contents of which are unknown. He was clad in a khadi cloth as he emerged from jail.

PREMIER'S DEFENCE OF DECISIONS MADE.

LONDON, January 25.

TEST FLIGHT.

TATAS TO ESTABLISH REGULAR SERVICE.

PUSS MOTH PLANE.

The campaign carried out by the Press and by commercial houses during the early part of the year for the establishment of a regular mail service between Bombay and Karachi is likely to be revived by Tata's.

**FROM THE
YERAWADA FILES**

Mahatma Gandhi's presence in Yerawada jail on several occasions ensured that it was the venue for many historic decisions and meetings. In 1930, when Nehru and Gandhi reiterated that they will not settle for anything less than poorna swaraj, the decision was taken in the chambers of Yerawada where Gandhi was lodged. On the day the peace negotiations failed, TOI reported in its September 6, 1930 edition: "The two peace negotiators, Sir Tej Bahadur Sapru and Mr. M. R. Jayakar, remained at the Yeravda prison for about an hour to-day. When they came out, they made the following statement: "We regret to announce that the present negotiations have failed. We are releasing the correspondence in the course of to-night or to-morrow."

The Yeravda Jail is rapidly filling with political prisoners, over 100 have arrived from Bombay recently. Inquiries are being made as to the likelihood of a further influx of prisoners as it may become necessary to open either the extension prison under canvas at Yeravda as was done last year to accommodate the political prisoners or alternatively the Visapore jail, at present closed down. It is understood that all preparations have been made to do either at short notice...
